SELLER INFORMATION

- ❖ Registration is from 8:00 am to 9:30 am.
- ❖ Any person, member or non-member, may bring tropical fish and related goods to be auctioned
- ❖ The auction will be set up with 20 tables numbered 1 – 20.
- ❖ Each person will put one item from their lot on each table starting at table #1. The table number must agree with the item number within your lot.
- ❖ If you have more than one lot, you will repeat the above process for each lot. There is a 2 lot (40 item) maximum and only one of your lots may have less than 20 items in it.
- ❖ When the auction begins, all items on table #1 will be auctioned before proceeding to the #2 table. When table #2 is finished, table #3 will be auctioned and so on until all the tables have been auctioned.
- ❖ All fish and plants should be properly bagged (i.e. no ZIPLock™ bags) and double bagging is strongly recommended. A charge of \$1.00 will be incurred if re-bagging is necessary.
- ❖ All fish and plants should be properly labeled with the species, ID, number of fish, and sex(es) if possible.
- ❖ All dry goods should be properly labeled as to their condition.
- ❖ Any item not sold will be re-auctioned after all other items are auctioned off. No exceptions.
- ❖ Any items not sold may be claimed within 30 minutes of the end of the auction or they will become the property of the club.
- ❖ Any minimum bids must be clearly labeled.
- ❖ Payment to sellers will be available one hour after the last table has been auctioned (time permitting).
- ❖ Cheques will be mailed within 2 weeks after the auction. There will be a \$1.00 charge for postage and handling.
- ❖ No Ontario Native fish will be allowed for auction.
- ❖ All bidders must register and have a bidder/buyer number in order to bid on auction items.
- ❖ **A driver's license or Photo ID is required for bidder registration. No exceptions.**
