

# PRAC 'Open Show' Rules, Sun Oct 27, 2019



1. **Anyone is Eligible** to enter any number of fish. Anyone whether Members or Non-members of Aquarium clubs are welcome to enter fish
2. **Show Containers** will be provided for Guppy & Betta entries only. Killifish entrants Must Provide their own water & clear container for each entry in show. (must have one flat side viewing area required & a lid to prevent jumpers!). One fish per container (except pairs).
3. **Show Registration:** 8:00am-9:45am (No Late Entries will be accepted). All entries must be benched & ready by 10:30am. Show Room **closes** 10:30am for Judging.
4. **Entry Fee:** \$2.00 per entry.
5. **All Entries** will be under the jurisdiction of the show chairperson until tear down (approx. 4:30pm.) and may not be removed from the show until conclusion of the auction, unless authorized by the show chairperson.
6. **No entry** may be entered in more than one class.
7. **Fish which Display** any disease or deformity will be disqualified.
8. **Judging by C.A.O.A.C.** certified judges and/or apprentice judges.
9. **Judge Decisions** will be final & not subject to appeal at the show. If in their opinion the entries in a class do not come up to show standards, a non-contest may be called. If there are only two entries that are satisfactory then any combination of 1st, 2nd and 3rd may be awarded.
10. **In Case of Dispute** the show chairperson's decision will be final and binding.
11. **No Poop**, snails, sand/gravel, plants etc. may be present in your show container.
12. **Entrants are responsible** to make sure your fish are in the correct class. Show chairperson will help upon request.
13. **No Aerosol Sprays** or mist type cleaners will be permitted in the show area.
14. **All Accessories** & equipment(pails, nets, etc.) to be kept out of sight during show.
15. **Auctioning Your Entries** - Any of Your Show Entries, if you wish, can go into our Auction after the Show. These items must be pre-registered the day prior before 6pm on [MyGroupAuctions.com](http://MyGroupAuctions.com). State IN ALL CAPS it's "**A SHOW ENTRY**" in your description online. Day-of-Show, register your items, then bring your sticker labels and show fish to the Show Chair, Morgan Ruttie.
16. **No Moving** other Entrants show tanks without approval of the chairperson first.
17. **Provisions** will be made for the well being of fish; however Peel Regional Aquarium Club is not responsible for loss or damage sustained during the show.
18. **Awards:** Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> in each Class & 'Best of Show' for each Category.
